AIM:

to get participants engaged in all aspects of running a simulated business, including market research, placing advertisements, logistics planning, selling services, and managing finances like wages, taxes, and benefits through the learning-by-doing methodology

participants honed skills in administration, ICT, time management, and intercultural business practices, all of which are transferable to various markets, countries, and work fields
